## **Charitable objectives**

- (a) The principal objective of the charity is to promote good health by advancing public education about the relief of suffering of people in pain, in particular by bringing together voluntary organisations established for the relief of pain sufferers in a common effort to improve their care, treatment and management.
- (b) To advance the education of the general public on the causes, effects, treatment and management of pain; and
- (c) To promote social inclusion for the public benefit among people living with pain who may be socially excluded from society, as a result of poor management of their condition and the physical, psychological and social problems that can ensue.

#### **Charitable activities**

The COVID-19 pandemic hampered activities during the year, however the Charity continued its work. These are the first accounts for Pain UK since becoming a CIO. During this year the Charity recruited a new trustee and progressed the UK Lived Experience of Pain Project (UKLEPP). Pain UK CIO transferred its funds to a new bank account with HSBC. At the end of the financial year, the charity had 36 charity members and over 1,200 individual members. During the year the Charity organised virtual meetings for its charity members and sent out many events and newsletters for both charity members and individual members. The Charity's two Facebook pages are very popular both with researchers seeking volunteers for their ethically approved projects and with individuals sharing pain stories.

#### **FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE**

### **Fundraising activities**

The charity received donations of £6,656.35 through Just Giving, Amazon Europe Core, Something Chronic, Giving Comm Ltd, Much Loved or individual donations.

**Income and Expenditure and Statement of Assets**
